Reading Read a selection of traditional tales - discuss the characters, setting and plot. Alternatively, watch a reading of a story on youtube. These would be stories such as 'The Princess and the Pea', 'Rapunzel', 'The Princess and the Frog' etc. There are also reading comprehensions on the Twinkl site listed below.	Write a list of questions you could ask the characters. Write a book review (What happens in the story, what was your favourite part/ character, how did the story make you feel, who would you recommend this book to?) Complete a reading comprehension from Twinkl. Compare the characters from some of the stories.
Writing Practise handwriting - examples are available from twinkl.co.uk Write a letter from one character to another e.g. an apology letter from the wolf to Red Riding Hood	SPAG Make a list of adjectives you could use to describe different characters. Collect adverbs to describe how characters do things. Learn the rules for past tense endings or the rules for plurals. Make a poster of the rules. (see twinkl or pinterest)
Science Investigate - find out what creatures live in your house / garden. Keep a diary of the animals you see each day. Make an identification chart to help younger children identify garden creatures. Test out your senses ○ Do a taste test. ○ Do a blindfolded smell test- can you identify foods by their smell? ○ Touch test - what do different foods / materials feel like? ○ How far away can you hear someone whisper in your house? Can you make a communication system?	Topic/ Research Find out where Africa is on the map. Find out how many countries are in Africa and some of their names. What is the sea near Africa called? Find out about homes in different parts of Africa. Find out about the wildlife in Africa. Compare the weather in Africa to the weather at home - make a weather report.
