Reading

This week see if you can find some non-fiction books. Remember fact books are non-fiction.

Does your non-fiction book have a contents page, index, subheadings, glossary or labels?

Writing

Can you make your own non-fiction text or book? You could make one about yourself, your family, one of your favourite things e.g. football or from your research on the Africa topic (from your previous research and below).

Remember to give your non-fiction report (or fact file) a title, subheadings and write in sentences. Challenge: Can you write using different features for each part? E.g. sentences, lists, picture with labels.

SPAG

Practise using commas in lists. Here is an example:

Mrs Rowe's favourite fruits are strawberries, apples, cherries and bananas.

There is a comma between two nouns (things) but the last one has and without a comma. Can you list some of your favourite animals, foods, books or all the things you can see out of the window?

Science

Can you research the life cycle of different animals? (Twinkl has some powerpoints on this)

Can you draw and then describe the life cycle of a chicken, a butterfly, a frog and a human? What is the same about these life cycles and what is different?

Topic/Research

Can you research the flags of the different countries in Africa that you found last week? Try drawing and colouring them. Which one is your favourite? Now research the flags of the UK. Challenge: Can you name all of the countries flags which make up the Union Jack?

Creative

Lots of children in the country have drawn or painted pictures of rainbows for their windows so other children can spot them when they go out for a walk. Could you make one for your house? Can you see anyone else's rainbows in their windows?
