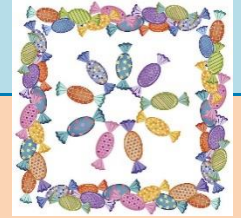




Pick and Mix Homework

Practise your number facts

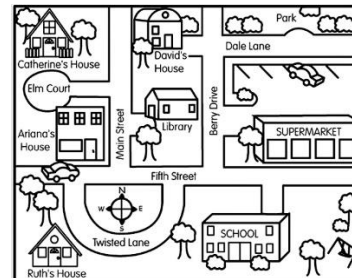
Use times table rock stars to practise your multiplication and division facts
